Y6 Football Match at Carr Mill

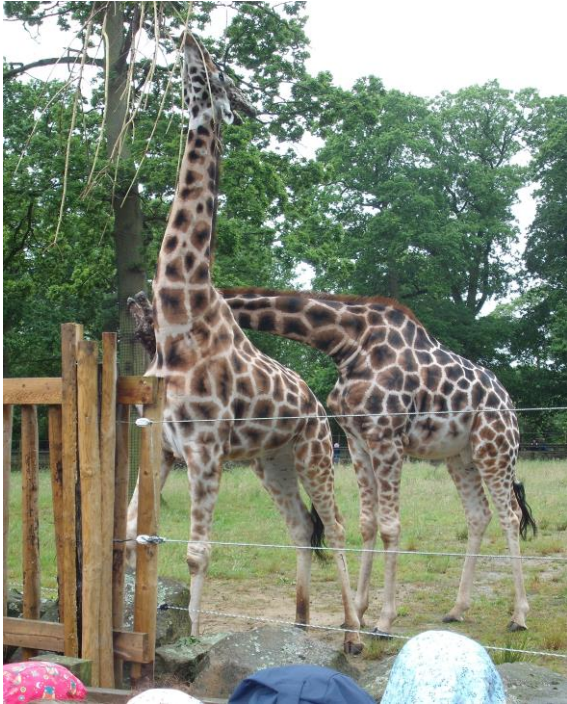
