Applications for Admission to Nursery School – January, April & September 2020

The online application system will be open via www.sthelens.go.uk/admissions from 10th June 2019 up to the closing date of 26th July 2019. **For Parents who have a child that will turn 3 on or between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020.**

Please note: If you apply for admission for the January or April after your child's 3rd birthday, places may be limited, as children who turned 3 on or before 31st August 2019 will have already been allocated places.

Your application is for the universal 15 hours: 30 hours of free childcare is only available to eligible families and will only be offered by maintained nursery schools if they have enough places.

Once you have been allocated a 15 hour place, you should contact the school to check if they will offer 30 hour places to eligible parents.
