Y4 Football



Payment proformas will be sent out to families next week. When we receive the returned proforma, school will add a payment option to your School Money account for you to pay £10 (per play), which should be paid by 16th December. Please note that no orders can be placed after 16th December.

Orders will then be sent to you before the Christmas break.

Please be aware that due to these uncertain times, if the play is cancelled you will receive a full refund.

PTA Christmas Fundraising Goes Online!

As you are aware, again it's been an unusual year for everyone! Sadly, we have not been able to run any of our usual fundraising and family-fun activities this year which includes the Christmas Fair. However, the PTFA elves are still busy behind the scenes supporting school and making plans to hopefully support the usual, lovely festive experiences that have become such a tradition for the children at Chapel End.
