Breakfast and After School Clubs

Bookings should be made **<u>a week in advance</u>**, but always by Friday for the following week. Please send booking requests by email to <u>chapelend@sthelens.org.uk</u>.

Please remember that payment should also be made in advance. Unless you are paying by childcare vouchers, club payments should be made through your child's SchoolMoney account.

When you log on to your child's SchoolMoney account please pay <u>the cost of what your following week's club</u> <u>attendances</u> will amount to to secure the place. If your child does not then need to attend on a day booked, the payment will go as a credit for the following week.

<u>REMINDER</u>: If your child will not be attending a Breakfast Club session please ensure you ring school and speak to a member of the Breakfast Club staff to inform them (01744 678230 option 3). Likewise, if your child will not be attending After School Club please leave a message with the school office.

Session costs are as follows:

Breakfast Club - £4.00 After School Club - £6.00

Bookings that are consistently not made the week before the required session will be charged at:

Breakfast Club—£6.00 After School Club—£8.00

School Meals

School meals cost £12.50 per week (£2.50 per day) and must be paid $\underline{in advance}$ each Monday.

Fish Friday (packed lunches Monday-Thursday and school meal on Fridays) this term will be £15.00 (6 weeks) paid <u>in advance</u> of the term.
