EYFS (Nursery & Reception)	Dried foods please, these could include pasta, rice, powdered milk, cup-a-soup etc.
Year 1	Tinned foods please, these could include tinned vegetables, beans, tuna, soup, fruit etc
Year 2	Toiletries, these could include Christmas childrens' toiletries, sham- poo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, shower gel, shaving foam, etc.
Year 3	Cereals please. These could include porridge, boxes of cereal, break- fast bars etc.
Year 4	Condiments please. These could include jam, marmalade, peanut butter, money etc.
