In the Early Phase, we provide a secure, friendly and exciting environment in which our younger children flourish.

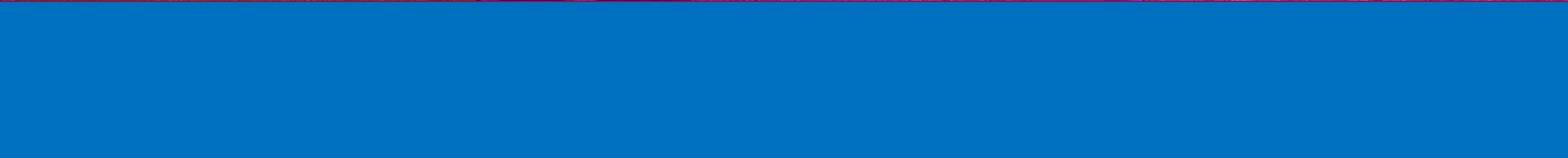
In Nursery and Reception, children work towards the Early Learning Goals and approach all aspects of learning through play.
