Change of Dinner Money arrangements

NB: Pupils currently in Y2 moving to Y3 in September are no longer entitled to Universal Free School Meals. Please see charges below.

Dinner Money Payments

Please note dinner money is paid **in advance of the week** via SchoolMoney. From September, dinner money will provisionally be £2.50 per day (£12.50 per week) (Please note this is still to be confirmed). We will let you know as soon as we have more information.

When you log on to SchoolMoney the figure shown is your current balance either in credit or debit as at that particular day.

Debit Balance

Please remember to pay the figure that is shown as owing **plus** the cost of any remaining meals due to be taken by your child for that week.

Credit Balance

If your balance is in credit, please ensure you have enough credit for any remaining meals due to be taken by your child for that week. If not, a further payment will need to be paid to bring your account up to date.

Fish Friday Payments

Please remember Fish Friday is paid **in advance of the term**. Fish Friday will provisionally be £17.50 in September (7 weeks). Please follow the same instructions above.

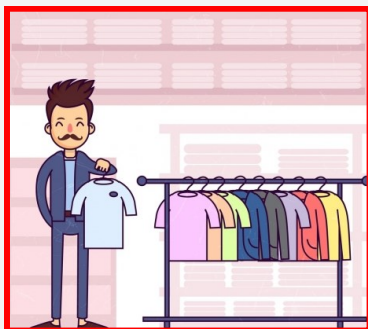
Nasal Flu Campaign 2021
