If your child had music tuition with the Schools Music Service last year please ensure that you have made a new application for this year's tuition to put your child back onto the teacher's pupil list.

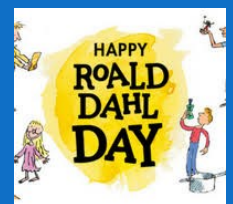
School Facilities Hire

Admissions to Secondary School - September 2022

Parents of Year 6 pupils will have received a letter from St Helens Council (or Wigan Council if you are a Wigan resident) about applying for a secondary school place for September 2022, outlining how you can apply online. NB: The closing date for applications is: **31st October 2021**.

Admissions to Reception - September 2022

To qualify for admission to Reception in September 2022, children must be aged four on or before 31st August 2022. If your child attends a nursery in St Helens, you should have received a letter from St Helens Council outlining how you can apply on-line.
NB: The closing date for applications for Reception 2022 is **15th January 2022**.

Admissions to Nursery - January, April & September 2022

If your child turns 3 after 31st August 2021 and you wish to apply for January, April or September 2022 admission please email schooladmissions@sthelens.gov.uk to request an application form as the online system has now closed.

Christmas Cards

Early next week, your child will bring home their own design for a Christmas card. This will be attached to an order form which, if you require cards, paper, mugs etc should be returned to school by **Tuesday 5th October**. All orders should be placed online following the instructions on the form and then the artwork will be collected from school on Wednesday 6th October, products will be delivered to school in good time for Christmas. **No money** should be sent into school as all of ordering and payments are now handled by the card company.
