Anti-bullying Week

Throughout the week the children will be participating in a variety of activities around the topic of anti-bullying and this year's theme 'Choose Respect'.

Afternoon Breaktimes

During the Autumn term of this year, we have monitored and reviewed our afternoon playtimes. This monitoring has revealed that a 15 minute breaktime outside in real terms takes children away from their lessons for over 25 minutes when we factor in toileting, snacks, putting coats on and moving out of, and into the building.

To improve our systems we are now operating lunchtime play from 12PM -1PM instead of 12pm-12:50pm. In addition, we will have an indoor break in the afternoon allowing children to have a piece of fruit or veg provided by school, a drink and time to use the toilet.

Our morning playtime has moved to 10:45am-11am to allow for lessons to be fully blocked.



Chapel End Christmas Lunch



On Friday 13th December all children from Reception-Y6 are invited to have a Christmas lunch at lunchtime. Nursery children who attend for a full day on Fridays are also invited (not 2's provision).

- 3. If your child is already on <u>school meals or fish Friday</u> no action is needed, please pay as normal and your child will automatically be provided with a Christmas lunch on Friday 13th December.

Reminder: Mrs Corr, our school cook, will need final numbers by <u>Friday 22nd November</u> to enable her staff to organise the ordering and delivery of food so please send any emails to the school office by <u>Thursday 21st November</u>.

New Wraparound Care Arrangements

Early Bird Club - Early Bird Club runs from 7.30-8.50am each morning.

Buzz Club - Buzz Club runs from 3.15-5.30pm each evening.

Parents and carers will be required to book \underline{ALL} of their wraparound care sessions for a half term before the half term begins. These sessions will need to be paid $\underline{in\ full}$ before half term begins. If the sessions are not used they will not be refunded. The cost of these sessions remain at £6 for breakfast club and £8 for afterschool care.

Once half term begins, parents can book any available remaining places, however any place booked at this point would be charged at a rate of £10.

Please note that these clubs are extremely popular and we are limited to numbers, so bookings should be made by emailing your requirements to the school office chapelend@sthelens.org.uk.

Half termly booking systems will come into effect on Monday 6th January. Please email all bookings which are for the first half of the Spring term (6/1/25-13/2/25) by Wednesday 18th December. These will then be added to SchoolMoney for you to pay in full before the term starts.



Winter Uniform



This half term all children should now be in full winter uniform.

Boys Uniform

Red round-neck school jumper preferably displaying the Chapel End Primary School emblem.

White polo T-shirt

Grey trousers

Plain grey socks

Black school shoes

Girls Uniform

Red round-neck school jumper or red school cardigan preferably displaying the Chapel End Primary School emblem.

White polo T-shirt

Plain grey pinafore, grey skirt (appropriate length) or grey trousers

Grey tights

Grey socks (recommended for winter)

Black school shoes

Haircuts

We do not permit children to have extreme haircuts such as shaved patterns or Mohican styles which cause a distraction to learning, as they are inappropriate for the school setting. Any child, male or female, with long hair length will be asked to tie their hair up.

Hair Accessories

We ask that hair accessories such as headbands, clips, bows and bobbles are red or black in colour. Please also ensure that they are kept to an acceptable size and keep them as plain as possible.

<u>Nursery</u>

Children of nursery age are permitted to wear black or grey jogging trousers to support gross motor skill activities and toilet training.







<u>Underlayers</u>

Due to the weather becoming colder, we would like to remind parents and carers that children can wear underlayers sometimes referred to as 'skins' beneath their normal uniform or PE kit.
