Queen's Platinum Jubilee

On Thursday 26th May Chapel End will be celebrating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee with a 'Street Party' for school lunch. The street party will take place outside on the Junior playground weather permitting.

All the children and staff may come to school dressed in red, white and blue.

The lunch will consist of party food: sandwiches, crisps, gingerbread men, muffins, packets of dried fruit, sausage rolls, jellies and soft drinks.

Please pay your dinner money as normal and your child will be provided with street party food on the day.

All children attending Nursery for 15 hours are invited to stay for the street party lunch. Please pay £2.50 via SchoolMoney and email school to let us know.

Families are invited to bring a picnic along to dine on the school field so that we can come together as a community to celebrate. Please note the school gates will be open from 1.00pm and closed promptly at 1.15pm.
